

Adopted User Fee Increases effective July 1, 2025

Overview

To meet the demands of our growing community and comply with state and federal regulations, the following wholesale rate increases were adopted at the North Davis Sewer District's regular Board Meeting held April 10, 2025.

Reasons for the adopted rate increase:

- The District has seen a 34% increase in operational costs since the last increase in 2017.
- The District continues to assess the condition of our infrastructure and estimates repairs and replacement of approximately \$130 Million in Collection System and \$80 Million in Treatment Plant over the next ten years.
 - Regulatory requirements for compliance with mandatory Division of Water Quality Phosphorous regulations.

Wholesale Rate Increases

Residential/Non-Residential Rates:

- Effective July 1, 2025: \$24.00/month
- Effective July 1, 2027: \$26.50/month

Non-residential or commercial connections excess consumption charges for water usage over 5,500 gallons:

- Effective July 1, 2025: \$2.40 per 1,000 gallons
- Effective July 1, 2027: \$2.65 per 1,000 gallons
